

The Table is Round, to show our everlasting concern for our missing soldiers.

The Tablecloth is White, Symbolizing the purity of their motives when answering their country's call to duty.

The Single Red rose, in the vase, signifies the blood they have shed to ensure the freedom of our beloved United States of America

The Red Ribbon, tied so prominently on the vase is reminiscent of the red ribbon worn upon the lapels and breast of thousands who bore witness to their unyielding determination to demand a proper accounting of our missing.

A Slice of Lemon, on the bread plate is to remind us of the bitter fate of those captured and missing in foreign lands.

A Pinch Of Salt, symbolizes the tears endured by those missing and their families seeking answers .

The Bible, represents the strength gained through faith to sustain those lost from our country, founded as **One Nation Under GOD**.

The Candle, is reminiscent of the light of HOPE, which lives in our hearts, to illuminate their way home, away from their captors, and into the open arms of a Grateful Nation.

The Glass, is inverted. They cannot toast with us today.

The Chair, is empty. They are not here.
